

In the past eleven years, over 45 college scholarships ranging from \$2,000 to \$7,000 have been granted.

- Complete and submit a typed three page, single spaced, as detailed in application.

Award Guidelines

All scholarship awards will be credited to the winner's college of choice. At no time are payments made directly to students. Application and essay must be submitted no later than Friday, June 5th, 2015. Winners will be notified by phone and/or mail by Wednesday, July 1st, 2015.

Essay Topics and Guidelines

- 1. There will be one essay that is to be three pages long, single spaced, 12 point character size and Times New Roman font.
- 2. Standard essay procedures must be followed, with exception to line spacing, crediting all outside sources appropriately.
- 3. Please include at the top of your essay the date submitted and title of the paper.
- 4. Your essay **must not include your name.** An evaluation committee of five individuals with an educational background will blindly judge the essay and rank the essayists to identify the highest scoring students. Weight will be given to student community involvement and outside activities.
- 5. Paper clip all 3 pages of the essay together.
- 6. All originals will remain intact.
