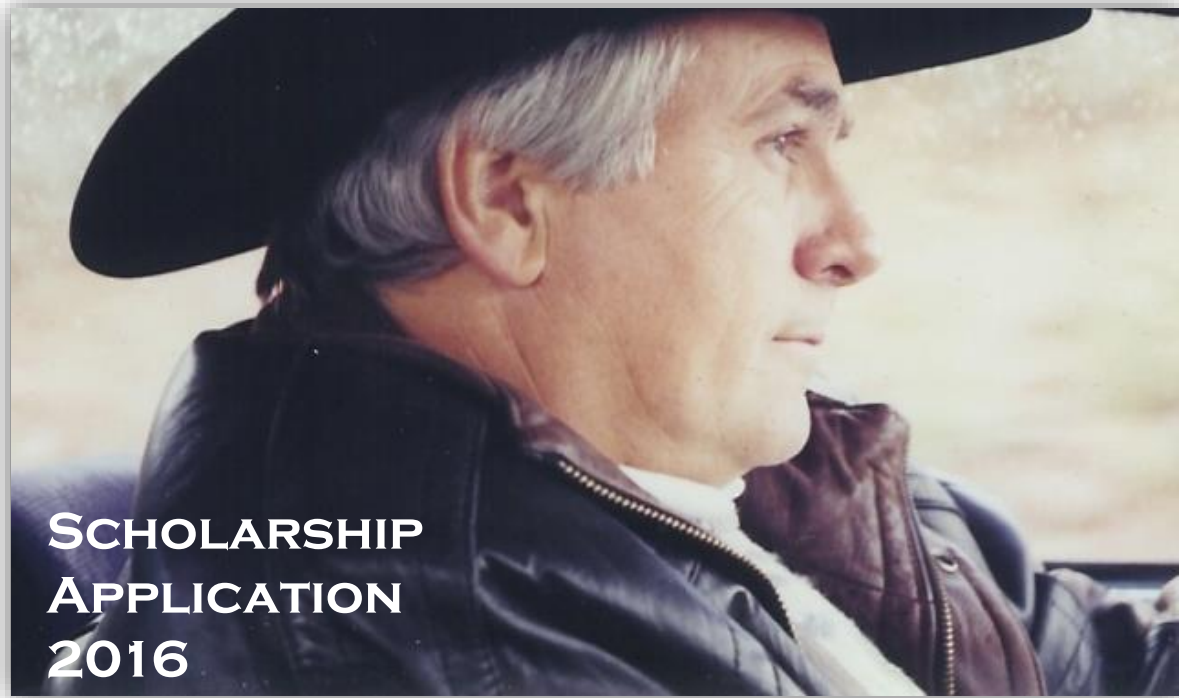

- Complete and submit the scholarship application in its entirety.
- Be enrolling or enrolled in 9 credit hours at college of choice.
- Complete and submit one three page, single spaced, typed essay as detailed in application.

Evaluation of Applicants

Selections will be based on essay content, structure, and individuality. An applicant's service to the community will also be a consideration.

Award Guidelines

All scholarship awards will be credited to the winner's college of choice. At no time are payments made directly to students. Application and essays must be submitted no later than **June 24, 2016**. Winners will be notified by phone and/or mail **by July 13, 2016**.

Please submit the following materials no later than **Friday, June 24, 2016**.

1. A completed scholarship application form.
2. One three page essay that involves all of the guidelines detailed below.
3. Signed certification and authorization.

Essay Topics and Guidelines

1. There will be one essay that is to be three pages long, single spaced, 12 point character size and Times New Roman font.
2. Standard essay procedures must be followed, with exception to line spacing, crediting all outside sources appropriately.
3. Please include at the top of your essay the date submitted and title of the paper.
4. Your essay **must not include your name**. An evaluation committee of five individuals will blindly judge the essay and rank the essayists to identify the highest scoring students. Weight will be given to student community involvement and outside activities.
5. Paper clip all 3 pages of the essay together. Please do not staple.
6. All originals will remain intact.

Considering the current allegations of police brutality and racial injustice, how would you format a plan to help ease tensions between the police and communities with people of color?
